

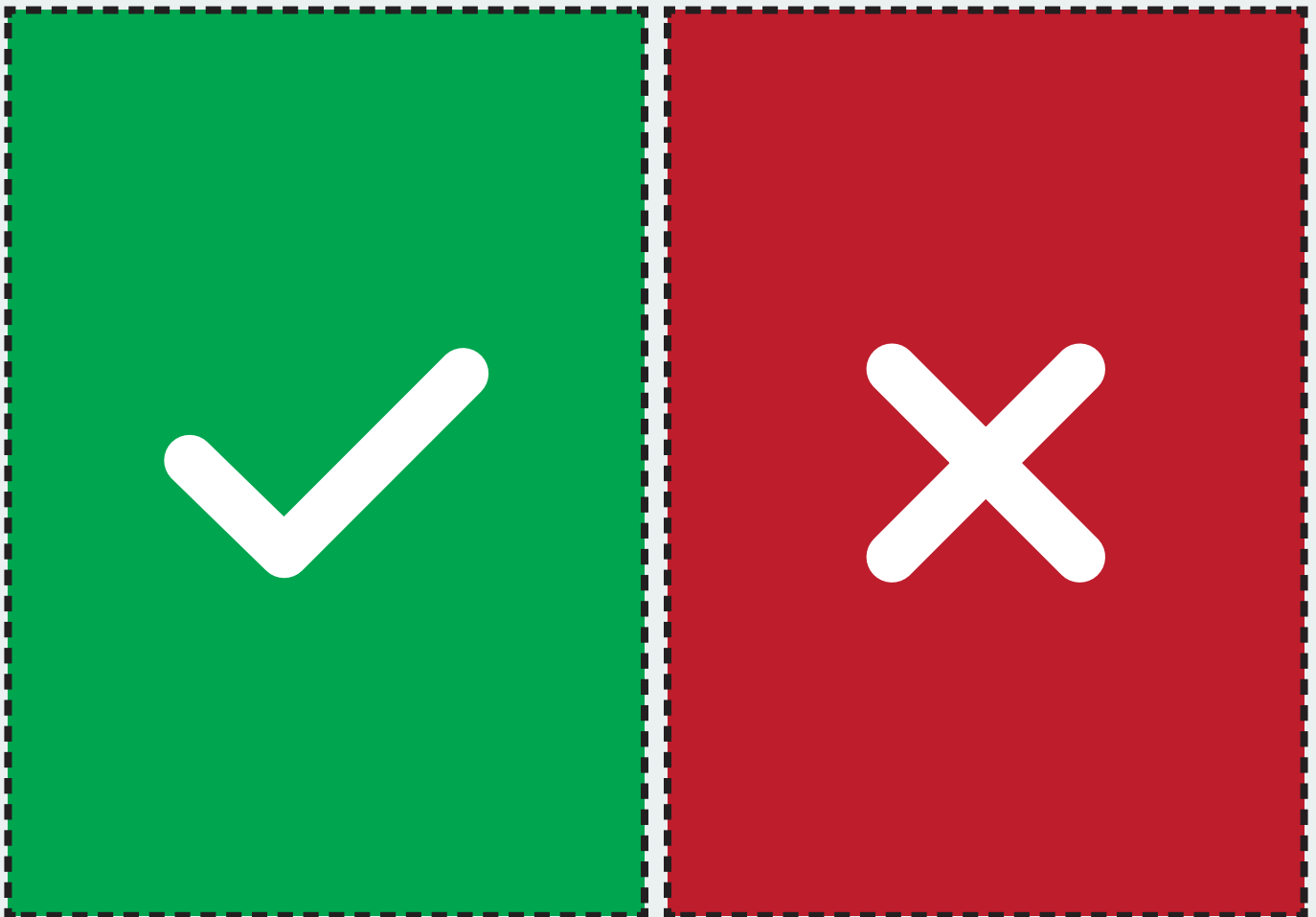
DOES IT NEED ELECTRICITY?

This activity is designed to help pupils in the early stages of the curriculum determine what items require electricity in order to work. The exercise will help promote skills involving classification into categories and reasoning.

Learning Objective: I can determine if items require electricity to work

Learning Experiences: I know how to stay safe when using electricity. I have helped to make a display to show the importance of electricity in our daily lives — **SCN 0-09a**

You can get your pupils to complete this activity in small groups, in pairs, or as individuals. Get them to sort the picture cards into piles of either 'Yes' (the item needs electricity to work) or 'No' (the item does not require electricity to work). You can use the tick and cross cards for this.



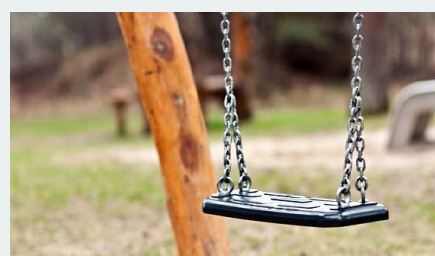
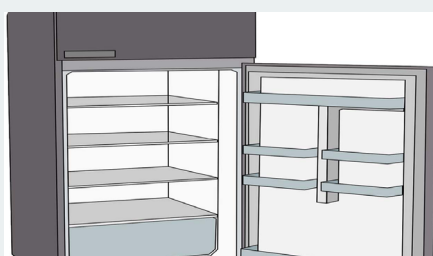
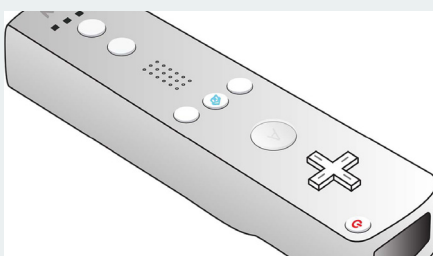
